- a) **Firm must have at least five (5) years of experience in printing of books/ manuals/ reports/ documents. Documentary evidence in the form of Work Orders/ Contracts/ Work Completion Certificates of each year of last 5 financial years of same must be submitted by the firm.**
 - b) **Firm must have minimum average annual turnover of Rs. 11,00,000/- for last 3 financial years. Documentary evidence of same (duly verified by CA) must be submitted by the Firm.**
 - c) **Copies of registration/ taxation documents (Company Registration Certificate/ PAN Card, GST Certificate, Aadhar Card, etc.) must be submitted by the Firm.**

 5. Quoted price will be evaluated and contract will be awarded to the responsive bidder offering the lowest evaluated rate.
 6. Bid should be accompanied by adequate technical documentation and catalogue(s) and other printed material or pertinent information for each item quoted.
 7. The deadline for receipt of bid through GeM is **16 March 2026 by 03:00 PM.**
 8. The prices should be quoted in Indian Rupees and should be inclusive of all taxes (GST). No price increase will be allowed after the submission of Bid.
 9. Validity of the Offer: Bid shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the date for receipt of Bid(s) indicated in Paragraph 7 above.
 10. Evaluation of Bid: The Procurement Committee of RECAP4NDC-PMU, ICFRE will evaluate and compare the Bid determined to be substantially responsive i.e. which are properly signed and conform to the terms and conditions and specifications of the Bid document.
 11. Award of contract: The contract for printing of training manual will be awarded to the Firm whose Bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest price as per the specifications in the Bid document.
 12. Notwithstanding the above, the ICFRE reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid and to cancel the procurement process and reject all Bids at any time prior to the award of contract.
 13. The Firm whose bid is accepted will be notified for the award of contract by the Purchaser prior to expiration of the bid validity period. The terms of the accepted offer shall be incorporated in the contract.

15. Standards: The printing of training manual supplied under the contract shall conform to the standard prescribed/ specifications mentioned in the bid document.
16. ICFRE shall not be responsible for fluctuation of the market rate of the ordered above mentioned works. The firm shall be required to supply the above-mentioned training manual at agreed rate only. The contract may be terminated at any time due to non-performance of any of the terms and conditions of the contract.
17. The Bid will be evaluated by the procurement committee of RECAP4NDC Project, ICFRE and the findings of the committee will be final and binding. The same cannot be challenged at any forum thereafter. Intending bidder will have to submit an undertaking in this regard.
18. ICFRE shall have the sole and unfettered discretion to decrease/ increase the number of above-mentioned training manual to be printed by the firm within the validity of the contract.
19. Payment shall be made after successful completion of work.
20. The Principal Investigator, RECAP4NDC Project, ICFRE reserves the right to cancel the contract on ground of unsatisfactory or delayed supply and failure to fulfill terms and conditions of the bid document and contract.
21. Materials of RECAP4NDC Project books/ manuals/ reports/documents is highly confidential and shall not be disclosed to third party in any case. Any violation in this regard will attract legal action.
22. Final drafts in colour (Colour Dummy) shall be made available to the Principal Investigator, RECAP4NDC Project, ICFRE and only after approval of the dummy, final print shall be taken.
23. Printed copies of training manual shall be delivered by the firm within 30 days. (Deliver the training manual to the destinations indicated in point no. 14).
24. The Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security 3% of the total contract value for the period of 06 months in the form of PBG or Fixed Deposit Receipt also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of 'ICFRE Security Money/ EMD Account'. The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledge.
